AGENDA APPROVAL - Case moved and Lund seconded to approve the agenda as amended. Motion carried.

Jim Wood, 420 Sherman, would like names on the facades of historical buildings to be more visible.

**STANDING ITEMS**

Minutes – Lund moved and Trevino seconded to approve Regular Meeting minutes of March 14, 2016, as presented. Motion carried.

Bills – Case moved and Lund seconded to approve the bills in the amount of \$51,632.78, as presented. Motion carried.

**REPORTS**

Police Report – Chief Dood, did not add to his written report.

DPW – Mike Vellanti, Supervisor, did not add to his written report.

Airport – Mike Matthews, Manager, added that he spoke with the airport’s consulting firm, Prein and Newhof, about the repaving of the airport taxiway.

Village Manager – Jake Eckholm reported on the feedback of the possible annexation, also noting that there will be a Public Forum on Monday, April 18<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m. He also reported on Tamarack Meadows, Sight Plan for the lake development, website design, DEQ building and summer help, and the upcoming Public Forum, which will be held April 18.

Village Manager Eckholm presented bids for the Web Site Redesign and recommended Revize Government Websites and City Web Central for the web design services. The Council discussed the bids and narrowed the selection to Revize and City Web Central.

Lund moved and Case seconded to table the selection of a web design service until the May Council meeting. The Council requested the Village Manager notify the remaining bidders of the selection. Motion carried.

Lund moved and Trevino seconded to accept Summerfest street closures as presented. Motion carried.

Lund moved and Case seconded to support Blue Star Mothers parade for September 11<sup>th</sup>, 2016. Motion carried.

Case moved and Lund seconded to approve fireworks and a beer tent for this year’s Summerfest, pending Chief Dood’s approval. Motion carried 5-0.
