

ORDINANCE NO. 4

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF PARKING LOTS OPERATED BY THE VILLAGE OF LAKEVIEW AND PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

THE VILLAGE OF LAKEVIEW ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of this ordinance the term "vehicle" includes every device in, upon, or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway, bicycles, farm implements or farm machinery with wheels attached.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firm, association or corporation to place any property other than a vehicle in or upon any parking lot operated by the Village of Lakeview.

SECTION 3. It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firm, association or corporation to leave any vehicle placed in or upon any parking lot operated by the Village of Lakeview for longer than 24 consecutive hours.

SECTION 4. It shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firm, association or corporation regularly engaged in the business of purchasing, selling, exchanging or dealing in new or used vehicles to place, or caused to be placed, any vehicle which he has for sale, exchange or dealing, in or upon any parking lot operated by the Village of Lakeview. Each vehicle so placed contrary to the terms of this ordinance shall constitute a separate violation of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. Any person or persons who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished for each violation on conviction thereof by a fine of not more than One Hundred Dollars, or by imprisonment in the common jail of Montcalm County for a period not exceeding ninety days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court, together and in case such court shall impose a fine and costs only, the person convicted upon failing to pay such fine and costs may be sentenced by the said court to be imprisoned in the said jail for a term not exceeding ninety days unless payment thereof be sooner made.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect on the 14th day of December, A.D. 1953.
