May 8, 2017**

AGENDA APPROVAL – Lobert moved and Case seconded to approve the agenda as amended. Motion carried.

**STANDING ITEMS**

Lobert moved and Fryover seconded to approve the regular meeting minutes of April 10, 2017, as presented. Motion carried.

Lobert moved and Case seconded to approve the bills in the amount of \$ 47,373.64, as presented. Motion carried.

**REPORTS**

Police Report – Chief Dood added to his written report and noted he had looked into a grant to purchase cameras through Chemical Bank, but a public entity is not eligible. He will be applying to the Lakeview Community Fund.

DPW – Mike Vellanti, Supervisor, did not have anything additional to add to his written report. He answered questions about the Spring Clean-up held in April.

Airport – No report

Village Manager – Shay Gallagher, Village Manager added to his written report regarding Parker Hannifin and their part in the lagoon clean out. Tenth Street water extension is going well and the sewer extension will begin. Manager Gallagher will have a DPW building presentation at the June Council Meeting. He also reported he attended a Redevelopment Readiness Committee seminar and MDOT Aeronautics grant training.

Chief Dood recognized Dan Kain for his dedication to the School, Village, and Community. He noted he attended a School Board meeting to share this recognition.

Chief Dood presented Officer Allen with a Meritorious Conduct Award for his outstanding service and dedication. Chief Dood read a letter outlining Officer Allen's Merit Award.

Shay Gallagher, Village Manager, presented a Cross Connection requirement that will be required by MDEQ. There will be a public hearing next month for Cross Connection for residential and commercial/industrial that will go into effect April 2018.

Lobert moved and Fryover seconded to adopt the Cross Connection Program. Motion carried.

Shay Gallagher, Village Manager, presented a DPW Director Contract that would be in effect through July 2018.

Case moved and Lobert seconded to approve the DPW Director's contract as presented. Motion carried.

Shay Gallagher, Village Manager, presented an updated Fee Schedule and Permit fees.

Case moved and Fryover seconded to approve fee schedule as presented with the exception the Fencing and Screenings be lowered to \$25.00.
