**VILLAGE OF LAKEVIEW
DDA Meeting Minutes
November 8, 2018**

Chairman Jonaitis called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Members Present: Edward Jonaitis, Ranny Leppink, Greg Mckenna, Ed Winter, Kevin Griffith, Barb Huttinga and Raymi Sunabe.

Leppink moved and Winter seconded to approve agenda as presented.
Motion carried.

Griffith moved and Winter seconded to approve minutes from August 16, 2018.
Motion carried.

Existing Business:

Pier/Dock Additions

Bids have not been solicited for the docks located at the end of the Alley and behind Mckennas. It was agreed that the Alley will be the main focus. The dock will be built in the T shape to be accessible for planes and boats. The DDA would like to have cost estimates on the Alley Dock and behind Mckennas lot separately. Also, one of the two together to see if there is a substantial amount of savings. These docks are in keeping with the Master Plan.

Sidewalk from 10th street to M46

Bids from Rowe and Prein & Newhof were discussed for the sidewalk addition. Concern was raised about the right of way regarding the businesses along the west of Lincoln. All parking for existing businesses would be affected if this were to happen. There is currently a sidewalk on the east side. Chief Dood mentioned the possibility of having cross walks put in to make it safer to cross. One being located near the Countryside Pharmacy/Little China restaurant and the second to be near the Subway/Tamarack Sports. This will be presented to engineers and discussed at next meeting.

Casair Downtown WIFI

There are issues with bringing the WIFI to downtown Lakeview. In order to get the signals that are needed, there would need to be businesses at each end of the block that would allow us to attach the device to the front of their building. Then we have the issue of electricity. There was discussion about people taking up needed parking spaces for the downtown businesses to use the free WIFI. It was decided to table the WIFI at this time.

New Business:

Small Business Saturday

Beth Nettleton, Tamarack District Library Director, intended to make it to the meeting to solicit funds from the DDA for Small Business Saturday. Unfortunately, due to circumstance she was unable to make it so I offered up the request on her behalf. Last year the DDA participated with the Library during Small Business Saturday. TDL purchased coffee cups with a picture of Lakeview Village on them. This event was well attended in the Village of Lakeview. Huttinga moved and Winter seconded to participate again in Small Business Saturday with Tamarack District Library. The amount spent not to exceed \$300. Motion carried.

Recently the home on the corner of Lincoln and Lake Drive came up for sale. It is in the Master Plan to purchase this property for Lakeside Development. Chief Dood will contact an appraiser to get a value on the house and discussion will continue at the next meeting.

The next meeting is set for Thursday, December 13, 2018 at 7:00 P.M.

Huttinga moved and Mckenna seconded to adjourn meeting at 7:40 P.M.
