The purchase agreements for 215 S Lincoln and 421 Washington have been signed.

The Pavilion project is underway. The Detroit Free Press is doing a follow up article on the site where the Kelsey Hospital was once located.

The DNR Trust Fund Board meeting will take place December 10th to see if we are awarded the grant for the trail around the lake. Two community members will be present at this meeting to speak at public comment to offer support for our community to receive this grant.
