**VILLAGE OF LAKEVIEW
DDA Meeting Minutes
June 7, 2018**

Chairman Jonaitis called the meeting to order at 6:32

Leppink moved and Winter seconded to approve agenda as amended. Motion granted.

Leppink moved and Winter seconded to approve minutes from March 29, 2018. Motion granted.

Public comments: None

No existing business.

Chairman Jonaitis started with an overview of the DDA and its purpose for the new members.

Winter moved and Leppink seconded to approve the Village Manager to negotiate the purchase of the "Bucholtz Lot" not to exceed \$30,000.00. Motion granted.

Dallas Lincoln spoke on the activity with Music in the Park. High energy bands are on the docket. Everything for Music in the Park has been donated so far. 150 - 200 people usually attend the event. 8 concerts booked for the 2018 summer series.

Winter moved and Griffith seconded to have concrete slab installed at the cost of \$1,700.00. Motion granted.

Make notice to public that we are looking for a Greenhouse to contract with for planting approximately 30 planters for the Downtown District for summer 2019. We would consider buying planters through the Greenhouse if they can purchase them for a reasonable rate. The Round Venus Planter and the Faux Stone Planter will be purchased so we can consider using them, if needed, for the plantings.

The Donation for Cindy's Walk will be revisited at next meeting after further research is done on guidelines for DDA.

It was presented that the DDA needs to bring more to the table and accomplish bigger goals. Before the next scheduled meeting for Tuesday, July 10, 2018 at 7:00, the current members of the DDA board will receive the 10-year plan that is currently in place. At our next meeting we will update the long-term and short-term goals that would like to be achieved and move forward from there.

Also scheduled for the July 10, 2018 meeting, electing a new chairman to the DDA Board. Current chairman is Jonaitis.

Motion by Mckenna and seconded by Winter to adjourn meeting at 7:27 P.M.
