SNOW REMOVAL

When you remove snow from your property or driveway, make sure you do not put the snow on the sidewalk or in a street right-of-way.

We would also like to ask homeowners and business owners to keep any hydrants that are located on, or in front of, their property clear of snow in case one is needed in the event of an emergency.

Odd/Even Parking Lot Regulations reminder. If the day of the month is *EVEN*, then you must park on the even labeled side. Example: If your car is parked past midnight on the 23rd day of the month then you need to be on the even side of the lot. If the day of the month is *ODD*, then you must park on the odd labeled side. Example: If your car is parked past midnight on the 14th day of the month then you need to be on the odd side of the lot. Odd/Even parking is a necessity in municipal parking lots to ensure these lots can be cleared of snow during the winter.
